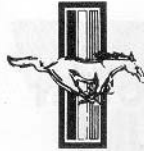

Model Building Rules for MCA

1. Any and all models to be accepted by the Mustang Club of America shall be of a scale less than 1:1 and represent that automobile that the club is based on (1964 to 1973 Ford Mustangs). The only exceptions shall be the proto-type models of the first experimental Mustangs (pre-1964).
2. The origin of the models shall be based around the body, interior, and chassis of the Mustang. Parts and accessories can be added from different kits or other sources.
3. The model does not have to be of kit origin. It can be a promotional model, toy, wood carving or slot car.

Dear Club Member:

We would like to invite you to the Eastern National Meet May 25, 26, & 27, 1979 in Chattanooga, Tennessee. We are expecting this to be the best meet ever. The headquarters motel and show site is centrally located with easy access to scenic and historic attractions, recreation, dining, and entertainment facilities. Chattanooga is a town in which you can spend a few days and have a very nice time.

The Ramada Inn-East Ridge will be our headquarters. The room rate is \$25.00 per night with unlimited occupancy. Roll-away beds, however, do cost an additional \$4.00. If you send in one night's advance deposit you will be preregistered and all you have to do upon arrival is sign the registration card and pick-up your key. Reservations must be made directly with the Ramada Inn-East Ridge, phone 615-894-6110.

We will have hosts and hostesses at the Ramada Inn and at the mall at all times to answer questions and to help make your stay as enjoyable as possible.

We will start setting up late Thursday afternoon for the early comers. The gates will open at 7:00 A.M. on Friday to begin the show and swap meet. We will be doing technical inspections all day. When a car enters the show area it must remain there until 5:00 P.M.

We are planning a get together on Friday night at the Ramada Inn pool at which time we will be giving away a number of door prizes. This event will begin at 7:00 P.M. At 9:00 P.M. there will be a judges meeting at the Ramada Inn.

Arrangements have been made with the motel to start a 6:00 A.M. breakfast buffet on Saturday. The gates will open at 7:00 A.M. with technical inspections from 7:30 A.M. to 9:30 A.M. Judging will begin promptly at 10:00 A.M. at which time you must have your car in place. No car will be allowed to leave the show area before 5:30 P.M. The serving lines for the banquet will begin at 6:30 P.M. and continue until 7:30 P.M. and the awards presentation program will start at 7:30 P.M.

Sunday morning there will be a devotional service at 10:00 A.M. at the Ramada Inn. Then at 1:00 P.M. we will start taking pictures of the winners at Eastgate Center.

We would like to have some judges from each regional group. We are looking for 20 to 30 judges. We believe with the new judging guidelines and this number of people we can finish the judging by 3:00 P.M.

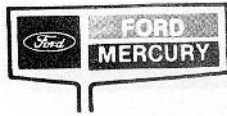
ONE VERY IMPORTANT ITEM: Registration packets will be picked up at the Eastgate Center headquarters only. There will not be a packet pick-up at the motel.
