1966 Mustang GT Convertible

I purchased my 1966 Mustang GT convertible in September, 1978, from Gast Classic Cars of New Holland, Pennsylvania. Gast Classic Cars is owned by Mr. and Mrs. Gast and their son, Jeff. They usually have 20-25 cars on display and all are for sale. None of them may contain any rust or damage. They must be originals. My '66 GT is an all-Mustang original from California. It has a new top, new Michelin radials and been repainted. The new paint was done by an antique car restorer and it is better than a factory paint job.

The car was made in California and ended up in Colorado on a collector's estate. This gentleman had 12 collector cars, one of which was my '66 GT. Mr. Gast bought 5 of these cars, mine being one of them.

The car runs and looks like new. From 1973 to 1978, the car was stored in a barn with the other eleven cars. The car has never been undercoated, and it is almost as clean as the day it was made. Mr. Gast believes the car was never driven in wet weather, and I haven't done so either.

I only drive the car, usually on Sunday, if the weather is nice for an hour or two.
