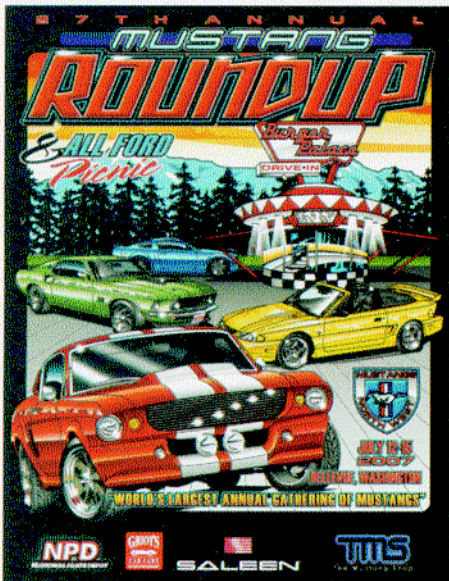


Mustangs at the Mill
