Thursday: A Unique Evening Event. The City of Concord has invited us to cruise downtown for a car show, dinner, live music and a movie under the stars at Todos Santos Park. The streets around the town square will be open only to Mustangs for this one of a kind event!

Friday: This is the day that your Mustang will be classified (put into the correct show category) by our Mustang Club of America trained judges. You will also be assigned your parking spot for the show. There will be a facility to wash and clean your Mustang and plenty of fellow hobbyists to make friends with at the Friday night Meet and Greet.

Friday at the Airfield: Photo opportunities with vintage P-51 Mustang aircraft will be available Friday (price to be determined). This is your chance to get a picture of your prized Mustang with it's deadly World War II namesake.

Friday Pony Drive: A planned cruise to the top of Mount Diablo will be leaving the show grounds and winding 3,850 feet up to the historic Works Progress Administration (WPA), 1930's vintage, Museum at the summit. On a clear day you can see San Francisco and the Farallon Islands to the west and the Sierra Nevada mountains to the east.

Saturday Car Show and Judging: This is the day you've been waiting for! Your Mustang will be judged by Mustang Club of America trained judges. You are also invited to spend time shopping and talking to the many vendors that will be present on the show field.

Saturday Night Hoedown: This unusual dinner with multiple buffets, dancing, hospitality rooms and western style fun will be entertaining for adults and children alike. Enjoy dancing to the Rock-A-Billy sounds of the Dave Crimmen Band. We guarantee that you've never had this much fun with your boots on!

Sunday Car Show and Awards Ceremony: Final judging will take place if required and then...the awards ceremony. This is when the rewards for all of your hard work are announced. Come and cheer for your friends or let them cheer for you!

Even if you can't bring your Mustang you can have a great time at the Wild West Mustang Nationals! Nearby shopping includes Sunvalley Mall and the Willows Shopping Center. There are many fine restaurants within walking distance of the host hotel. Water World USA and the Buchanan Field Golf Course are also nearby.
