In first grade the teacher wrote a new word for us on the black board—ISLAND. She then asked the class, what is that word? Most of us shouted out, "Is Land." Wrong!

People did get an "F" in school. Those of us who didn't get them looked on with pity and revulsion. Sympathy was not a common emotion in public school. But, most of us were duds in class most of the time in grade school and probably deserved an "F" or something worse.

I don't think I have ever been to a Mustang Club that wasn't great. Some more so, and some a little less! Regional Mustang Clubs provide the gathering place, at least monthly, where more than 70 percent of the members of THE MUSTANG CLUB OF AMERICA go for fellowship and support.

Those Clubs that work the hardest should be honored. Annually, we present these outstanding clubs the PRESIDENT'S AWARD. No later than July 2nd of this year, Regional Clubs are invited to have submitted applications that list their accomplishments during the 2006 calendar year. Points can be accumulated from a list of 18 opportunities. A total of 100 points are required to qualify for the PRESIDENT'S AWARD.

Clubs earn points by publishing a newsletter, participating in parades, or by providing a newspaper clipping about their club. Clubs with 100-percent MCA membership earn 20 points right off the top. There are different point values for local shows and events, National Shows, as well as for sponsoring local charities. If a Club sends in a show article to the *Mustang Times* or a club member's car is featured in the *TIMES*, the club gains points. Gold Card Judges and Certified Judges qualify a club for points, and an increase of every MCA member is worth 2 points.

Other activities that can earn points for your club are attendance at National or Grand National shows by club members, sponsoring cruise nights, members attending an MCA Board meeting, and attending the National Judges meeting.

The Regional Director, or the Club President, should write, fax, or email the MCA office to order an Application and Checklist. The rules are simple. The Regional Support Committee will do the tally and ranking.

The presentation of the PRESIDENT'S AWARDS will occur during the 2007 GRAND NATIONAL SHOW in Augusta, GA. And a special award will be made this year to the Regional Club that documents the highest point total.

No one gets an "F," if they try. We are all winners if we extend our hand in greeting to a new club member.
