From the MCA Nominating Committee

We need your help and support to make MCA the premier auto club in the world. We cannot do it without you, and I mean you! If you love your Mustang and everything it stands for, than you will want to help MCA. We need dedicated individuals who feel it a personal accomplishment when they can be part of a team that makes things better for everyone associated with our Mustang family.

At the end of December 2007, 12 Board of Directors' terms will expire. It's time to consider submitting your name in nomination for one of these positions.

The requirements to serve as a Director are: You must be an active member of the MCA in good standing, and you must be 18 years of age before October 1, 2007.

Before you decide to run for the Board of Directors, you should be aware that serving on the Board is not a name-only, honorary position. You will be required to put forth effort, which includes sacrificing some of your personal time.

Meetings are held the second Saturday of every other month. You will be required to attend Board meetings at your personal expense. Some meetings are held in Atlanta, Georgia, or in other cities such as Flat Rock, Michigan, and possibly at a National Show. You will serve on at least one MCA Board Committee and will be required to attend meetings called by the chair of those committees—some of these meetings are held via conference calls. As with many businesses and organizations, there are many issues that will be discussed and many decisions to be made. Issues discussed and those evaluated and passed by the various Committees are then presented to the full board for approval.

Although this is a hobby, the Board operates like a business and is accountable to all members much like a business and its stockholders.

Additionally, you may spend a great deal of time talking to Regional Groups and others by phone. You will be a representative of the MCA at any National, Grand National, and/or Regional event you attend, and will be expected to convey the positions of the Board to members and non-members alike while at those events.

A director with six months of inactivity may be removed from the Board at the discretion of the Board of Directors.

You will not be compensated monetarily, however your compensation is knowing that you have an important part in running the largest club in the world dedicated to the preservation of the Mustang hobby.

Give this opportunity serious consideration before making a decision. Our goal is to have a diverse Board with members representing all areas of the country. What better way is there for you to share our passion and ideas than to assist in growing the MCA and getting the work out that we are truly a club for all generations of Mustangs and their owners and enthusiasts.

To make your intentions known, you must submit a biography of no fewer than 250 and no more than 300 words to the Nominating Committee Chairman. (Biographies longer than 300 words are subject to editing.) Included in the bio should be your name, MCA membership number, city of residence, local club affiliation, past or present offices held within the MCA or Regional group(s), and any other information you deem important or appropriate. A recent photograph of yourself must accompany your biography.

Time is of the essence in this endeavor. To have the biographies and photos run in the September 2007 issue of *Mustang Times*, **all submitted information must be received by the Nominating Committee Chairperson no later than July 20th!** Please adhere to this deadline. Bios and photographs received after this date will not be accepted into nomination.
