PINNACLE AWARD

The Mustang, Modified or not, is considered to be an expression of an individual's extension of himself or herself in terms of conceptual design, and quality building of a special automobile. These cars represent free thinking with no limitations on far-out design, testing the limits of imagination and challenges of creating a functional and beautiful Mustang. When completed, the owner can truly say, "I did it my way!"

The MCA Board of Directors and Judges realize that we must recognize those special individuals who created this special breed of Mustang. MCA was acutely aware that special awards were given to other groups, e.g. Non Concours, Concours, Thoroughbred, and Unrestored Classes. Based on discussions with MCA members, I was in a position to develop and propose a special award for all of the Modified Classes—The Pinnacle Award. This proposal was presented at the November 4, 2006, Judge's Meeting in St. Louis, MO. It was approved unanimously and subsequently approved by the MCA Board. This recognition will only be awarded at Grand National Shows.

Here are the requirements for winning the Pinnacle Award in each of the six established Modified Classes:

Special Bonus points for each of the six Modified Classes:

National Shows

1st Place = 8 Points

2nd Place = 6 Points

Grand National Shows

1st Place = 10 Points

2nd Place = 8 Points

Those Modified Cars with the highest total points, at the end of the show year, win a special Pinnacle Award for each class.

The advantage of this new award is an incentive for owners of Modified Mustangs to participate in as many shows as they can in order to accumulate points.

PLATINUM AWARD

An Unrestored Mustang is considered to be of historical value and one that can be referred to by other Mustang enthusiasts desiring to restore their Mustang to Concours original. To recognize Unrestored Mustang owners who have conserved their original Mustang to the highest degree possible, MCA will honor those individuals with a Platinum Award. This relatively new award, as suggested by Bob Perkins, initially began 2005, well also only be given at Grand National Shows.

Requirements for the Unrestored Platinum Award (both elements below, must be satisfied) are as follows:

- Must score a Gold Award (95% of total points) in normal MCA Unrestored Judging.
- Must score 98% of the total points. Bonus points will be factored in, when determining qualifications for the Platinum Award.
