




1969-1970 Mustang door sill plates stamped from the original Ford tooling at Carpenter's facility. Made precisely the same as the ones that came down the assembly line.

Last but not least when you see our scuff plates installed in your classic Mustang they look like they belong there, bright finish, crisp details and all.




