Hello Bob,

Several months ago, a couple of MCA's judges began writing rules to guide judging of these rather unique Mustangs but as yet nothing has come of this effort. These Cobras are currently in class OS ('93-'99 Cobras All), and are judged utilizing the 4th Generation judging sheets for Concours Trailered and Concours Driven Mustangs. Cobras in the OS class are a fairly rare breed. For example, there was a total of only seven Cobras in this class during the 2009 show season. Nonetheless, every effort is made to utilize judges who are knowledgeable of the uniqueness of these vehicles at MCA National shows.

We'll keep you posted when judging sheets are available for '93-'00 Cobra Rs.
