I am happy now to have been given an awesome opportunity to not only be a part of the National Board of Directors but to work where my passion is...with the members of MCA.

There is always such new excitement and goals associated with a new year. The excitement and goal setting was felt at the first meeting of the 2010 Board of Directors with the newly elected and appointed positions on the MCA National Board. All members of the Club Support Committee are excited and passionate about our obligation to improve the communication between the National Board and the Regional Clubs. Our committee will provide all aspects of support needed for established MCA Clubs. The 2010 committee members are Bill Birch, Jim Keenan, Rick Lawless, Deb Miles, Chris Neri, and Pete Sigwardt.

I would like to share two important goals we have set. First, we will post current contact information on the MCA website for all members to have access. Second, we will strengthen communication with Regional Clubs. In order to get started in meeting our goals, Chris Neri has compiled a current listing of all MCA Chartered Regional Clubs, along with the listed President and Regional Director of that club, based on what currently is posted on the MCA website as of February 1, 2010.

GOAL 1:

According to the MCA by-laws, it is the responsibility of the regional club to annually submit the following:

1) A list of all regional club members as of June 1st of the current year. You should submit your 2010 information to me via the MCA website under tab for Club Support, or email me directly at Bo.lawless@yahoo.com. If you prefer to use regular mail, send to:

2) This update should include a club email address (if applicable), and contact information (e.g. email address, club address, phone number) for the Club President and Regional Director. We need this information current in order to be able to effectively communicate with the Regional Clubs.

GOAL 2:

We plan to take a more active role in the communication with the Regional Clubs. This communication will be in place to help Regional

Directors be more effective and more knowledgeable of the National Club business. Success of any organization is based largely on open and constant correspondence. The Regional Director is a member of the National Club Board of Directors and is entitled to vote at all National Board of Directors meetings. The Regional Director may submit a proxy in lieu of attendance at National Board of Directors meetings. To assist each Regional Director in the completion of such a proxy, the National Club will provide each director an agenda of each Board meeting at least 10 days prior to the meeting, along with a proxy form that enables the director to provide a "For" or "Against" vote on agenda items requiring a vote. If for any reason an individual is appointed or elected as a Regional Director for more than one regional club, the individual shall only have one vote on any National Club Board actions.

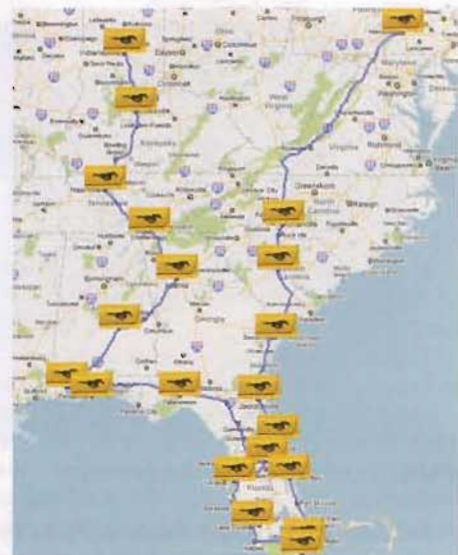
