

IMPORTANT INSURANCE INFORMATION — PLEASE READ!

The MCA insurance program consists of two highly important policies:

1. It has come to our attention that some MCA Regional Clubs hold car shows and driving events believing their event is automatically covered by the MCA's National Insurance Program. **This is not true.** Your club must apply for and receive an insurance certificate for any event to be covered. Please follow the procedure outlined below.

The Mustang Club of America purchases General Liability coverage for the approximately 137 events (car shows and track events) sanctioned by the MCA and the 5 annual National/Grand National events from our MCA Corporate Sponsor, Heacock Classic Insurance. We refer to that coverage as the MCA National Insurance Program. Coverage for these events must be approved by the MCA Insurance Committee and the MCA office using submitted MCA Event Insurance Applications. Contact the MCA office for the form via email at mcaofficemanager@cox.net, or by calling 850.438.0626, 10am - 5pm Monday to Friday (Eastern).

There is no charge for insurance to the MCA Regional Clubs for sanctioned events but coverage must be applied for well in advance and be approved by the MCA Insurance Committee before your event can be covered and a certificate issued.

2. MCA Regional Clubs frequently conduct activities not covered by the MCA National Insurance Program. This is why Heacock Classic Insurance offers a \$1,000,000 General Liability Insurance policy at a reduced rate under the MCA insurance umbrella for individual MCA Regional Clubs. This insurance is strongly recommended to cover club activities such as meetings, social events, picnics, cruise-ins, etc. For information, contact the MCA Insurance Committee Chair, Ed Hockaday at 281.496.9800.

Premium is calculated using a \$3.50 charge per member (family) with a \$300 annual minimum premium. The completed application and check for the premium are to be mailed directly to Heacock Classic Insurance. The address information is on the form.
