We love everything about the 2011 & 2012 Mustangs but the plastic trim is a nightmare to wax around. I know from the trim on our 2004 Escape that one slip of the applicator and you have dull white areas on your trim that are impossible to get out. So, every time except the very first wax job I have used blue 3M painter's tape around every surface of the black trim. We have no white wax residue on the trim and the actual wax jobs go faster when the trim is masked. It may look goofy as all get out but hey, it works.
