Obsolete Ford Parts Company was founded in May, 1950, to supply new, genuine Ford parts to restorers. Since their beginning, the goals of the company have been to supply these parts at reasonable prices and to supply them with prompt, efficient service.

Approximately 85 percent of Obsolete's customers are mail order ones. It is a credit to Charlie Jones and his staff that virtually all of their mail order customers have their orders shipped out the same day that they are received.

In January, 1980, all 1948 and earlier parts were discontinued at Obsolete Ford Parts Company, Inc. Since that time the company has moved to increase its inventory of 1949 and later parts. Broken down into categories, Obsolete carries parts for 1949-72 full-size Fords, 1965-73 Mustangs,

1962-71 Fairlanes, and 1960-70 Falcons. Parts are also stocked for 1948-66 Ford pickups with a limited inventory of 1949-71 Mercury parts, too.

Obsolete carries a full-line of parts including mechanical pieces but the house specialty is trim. Fenders, other sheet metal, bumpers, grilles, wheel covers, moldings, ornaments, nameplates and dash pads are just some of the items stocked. The company also handles soft trim and carpets as well as original literature and detailing supplies.

Obsolete Ford Parts Company is located at 311 East Washington Avenue in Nashville, Georgia. Store hours are 8 am - 5 pm, Monday through Friday and 8 am until noon on Saturday.
