CAR EXCHANGE To Feature Mustang

One of the best things about being into collector cars now is that there is a lot of stuff being published in the old car field, including a number of magazines. One of the best is one devoted to the postwar car collector and is called *Car Exchange*. A recent conversation with Chris Halla, editor of *Car Exchange*, confirmed that the magazine's February 1981 issue will feature the Ford Mustang. Chris referred to several interesting articles that he had planned for the issue, including a Mustang convertible buyer's guide and a feature on the new McLaren Mustang. Look for this on your local newsstand in early January.
