REGIONAL GROUP NEWS

Old business was dredged up in the form of T-shirts and the club decals, official and unofficial. The NCRMC logo is a running horse silhouetted against the Nation's capitol enclosed in the familiar corral. The unofficial version is a somewhat elderly nag, swaybacked and with the look of having been around the track a few times, but with a gleam in his eye and smile on his face--sort of gray but game. Both decals are now for sale at \$3 each. Members were cautioned not to try to apply the decals with customary hot iron to nylon jackets. Wayne Kvasnicka lamented he now has neither decal or jacket. Wayne reminded members of the fall Carlisle meet in October and recommended that NCRMC purchase two display spaces as it has in the past. He also mentioned that Mustang Monthly has donated two yearly subscriptions as door prizes. Woolco, the host for the annual event has donated two cases of oil for door prizes. He went on to say that invitations to 43 vendors have been mailed for the show. Wayne next discussed the Shenandoah Mustang Club's recent meet and modestly admitted without being asked that his '66 GT fastback had placed second in the 65-66 class. "The quality and quantity of the cars in the Shenandoah Club have improved dramatically and I hope we can work out some way better reciprocal support on the part of Shenandoah and NCRMC," Wayne concluded.

Wearing his Activities Chariman's hat, Bill McHugh again took the floor with some useful ideas on how to gain Ford dealer support as well as contributions. Dealers who participate will be given free one-page ads in our 2,500 flyers. Another selling point was that the display of an early Mustang and accompanying dealer purchased trophies can generate considerable traffic--and sales. Bill continued with extensive plans for the July Show including the breakdown of Mustang classes and the purchase of 37 trophies to be awarded. He gave a projected idea of vendor participation and cars to be judged, plans for the public address system, tables, chairs and the borrowing of a van or trailer. He then finished with a reminder for members to exert a good effort to encourage dealer participation and donations. Publicity Chairman, Art Mullins, reported on the publicity campaign for the July Car Show. Press releases will go out to 32 newspapers in the capital region. Local radio stations will be furnished with radio copy on the event. Art has written notices of the event which have already appeared in Hemmings, Old Cars and Parts, Old Car Weekly and Car Exchange. He encouraged members to distribute flyers to auto parts stores, parts dealers and service stations and reminded the membership in attendance that a major effort in member participation and program advertising sales is essential to make the second annual event a success. Art went on to say that the Ford Motor Company's Washington Public Relations has promised support for the show.

Art concluded with a reminder that "Quarterhorse" ads are needed to make it a self-supporting publication and that all members also are encouraged to obtain business card, one-half or full page ads for the July 13 programs for the show.

Membership Chairman, Bill Ross, Sr., passed on the results of his recent newspaper membership drive and discussed plans for the manning of the membership booth and called for volunteers. Volunteers are also needed for parking, Coke sales and the registration booth.

Bill Cullins, Judging Chariman, elaborated on the organization of the individual Mustang classes, a judging timetable and discussed the examinations recently given to prospective judges. "All judges will be needed on July 13 in order to complete the task", he said.

The meeting was adjourned and all dashed to the parking lot for tire kicking and tall tales.

Next meeting, same time--same place on August 19th.
