This Mustang was originally purchased from Lou Miller Ford in Dover, New Jersey. It represents one of 40,970 Mach Is manufactured by the Ford Motor Company as 1970 models or roughly 21.4 percent of the 190,727 Mustangs of all models produced that year. The car carries a selection of optional equipment including the 300 hp 351-4V Cleveland engine, a four-speed transmission, a Tranction-Lok differential, SelectAire air conditioning, tinted glass, a Stereosonic tape system, sport slats, and rear deck spoiler. Of course, all options mentioned were factory installed at the time of manufacture.

As would be expected from consideration of the delivering dealer, this car was manufactured at the Metuchen, New Jersey, assembly plant, where it was constructed on March 19, 1970, about mid-way through the 1970 model's production run. The car has seen most of its miles since that date in the northeastern section of the country.

I began the restoration of this vehicle in April 1979 and completed it in March 1980, in time for the car's tenth birthday.
