Classifieds Policy Changes

Due to a recent decision by the national board of directors, the *Mustang Times'* classified advertising policy has undergone a few changes. From now on, members will be limited to one thirty (30) word advertisement per month. The directors felt that one could accurately describe a car for sale in this many words or could indicate what parts were for sale or to send for a list. A factor in making this change is the increased cost of typesetting the magazine. It was also found that this figure is approximately what other car clubs have found to be an optimum number of words in their free classifieds. We will continue to print the longer submitted ads for a short time, until everyone has had a chance to be aware of the new rules. After that time, longer ads will either be edited to the shorter length (if easily done) or omitted altogether.

Another part of this recent classifieds policy change is that commercial advertisers will no longer be allowed to use this section. Any ads submitted which appear over anything but an individual member's name will be refused. The board felt that commercial advertisers should place their ads in the display advertising portion of the magazine. Ad rates for the *Mustang Times'* display advertising are among the lowest of any club publication and there is the added advantage of the monthly frequency, which is very unusual for a club magazine. We know that the ad rates are going up again soon, as much as we hate to think of it. We urge all commercial advertisers to place their ads now, before this increase occurs. Also, please note that there is an ad surcharge for display ads that are not camera-ready when submitted. This is just the result of an economic fact of life. Any non-camera-ready display ads submitted with camera-ready payments will be refused until the amount of the surcharge is submitted, too.
