

Rulebook Ready

New copies of the 1981 Mustang Club of America Judging Rules now are available from national headquarters. These are almost exactly like the eight inner pages of the February issue, with the exception that the errors that have been found between then and now have been corrected in these self-standing rules booklets. The books are the same page size as the magazine but are considerably better in terms of paper quality (the cover is 80 lb. stock; the inside is 50 lb.). This size will allow room to make notes on the pages if rules changes are made and the paper will allow plenty of hard use before becoming too worn to be serviceable.

The price for the rule book remains one dollar and fifty cents per copy. Orders which were on hand for the 1981 rules have been shipped and the checks we were holding have been cashed. If you placed an order for a 1981 rules book and have not received your copy by the time you read this, please notify the national headquarters at P.O. Box 447, Lithonia, Georgia 30058. As we mentioned before, this also is the address to which orders for the 1981 rules book should be addressed.
