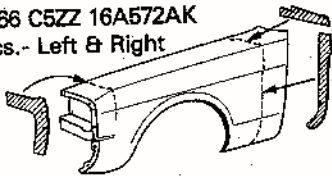
## Scenic City Regional Group

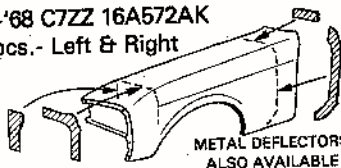
