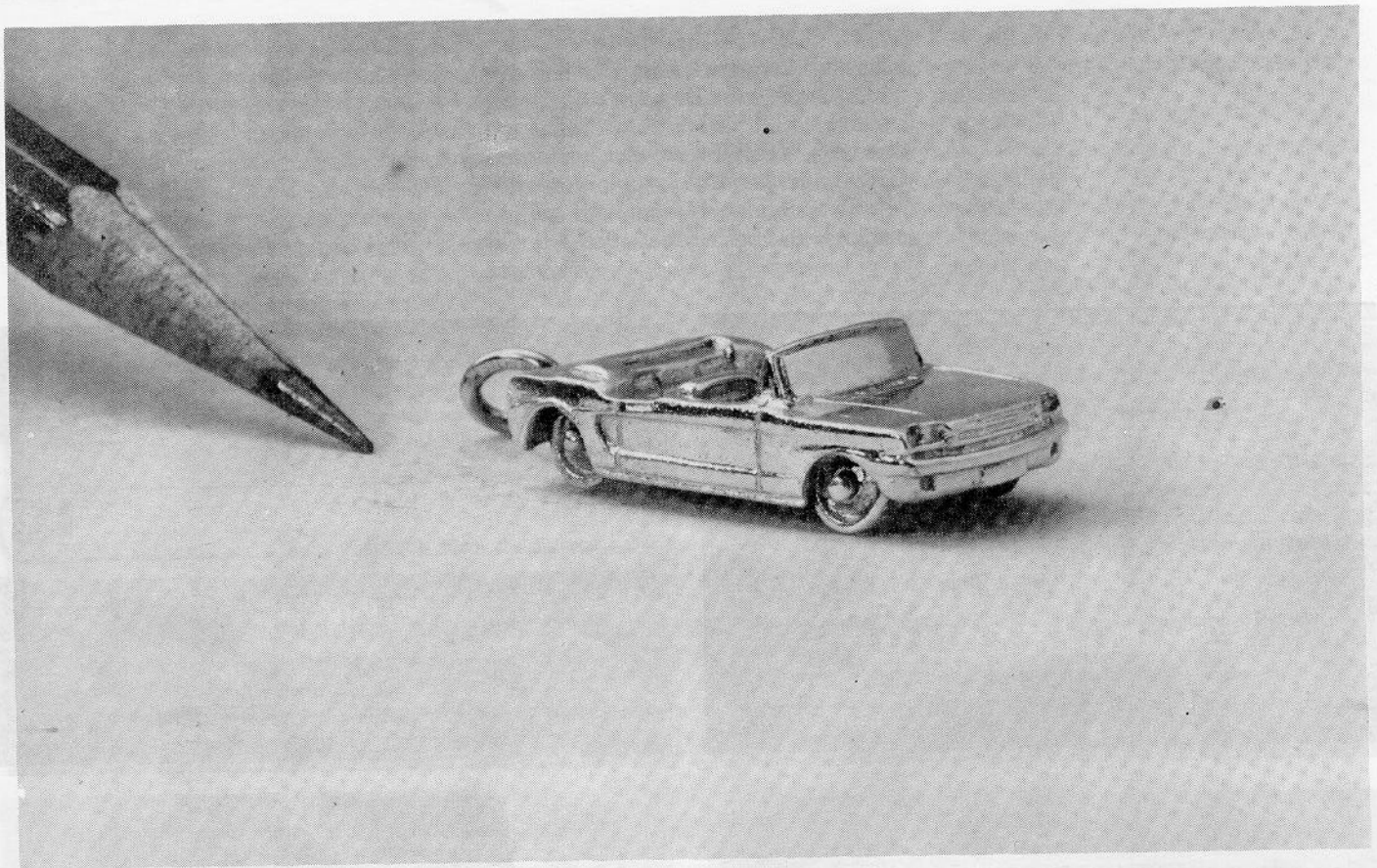


World's Smallest Mustang?
