

National Board Meeting Report

The November 10, 1981, meeting of The Mustang Club of America was called to order by President, George White.

Roll call was made and the minutes of the October meeting were read and approved with the following addendum:

A suggestion was made that someone write an article on the history of our club to appear in the December issue of "The Mustang Times". Motion was made and seconded that the article be written and a maximum of \$200 be paid for the article would be \$200.

Old Business:

Bill Koivu gave the treasurer's report for the months of September and October. This report was approved as stated. Bill stated that we still have received no word on our appeal filed with the I.R.S. We have not yet heard from the Post Office concerning our second class mailing permit.

The club now has a card to be used when a gift membership is purchased. The card may be used for all occasions and will be sent to new members immediately after application is received.

Mel Parks read the list of 1982 Board of Directors nominees. This same list is to appear in the November issue of "The Mustang Times" in the form of a ballot.

Two new regional groups whose group charters were previously approved were again presented for approval of their maps. The maps for the Northeast Pennsylvania Regional Group and the Central Jersey Mustang Club were approved.

New Business:

Horace Wood presented a new regional group called "The Bluegrass Mustang Club of Kentucky" to the Board for approval. The group and territory map were approved as presented.

John Henderson asked where the current By-Laws could be located. He was advised that they appear in the 1981-82 Roster and are current including all recorded amendments.

Bob Vickery will appoint and chair the 1982 Judging Rules Committee. There should be no major changes made other than possibly the classes. The 1981 Judging Rule books are completely sold out. Bob will try to have the 1982 Rules ready for publication in the February, 1982, issue of "The Mustang Times."

A suggestion was made that our judging rules and club logo should be copyrighted. George White has all the necessary forms to accomplish this.

The Copperstate Mustang Club sent a letter in response to a previous request made by Teresa Vickery for a current membership listing of their group. The letter was read for information purposes only and stated that the group does not and will not require their members to join The Mustang Club of America. This is in direct violation with the group's charter. Teresa will notify the group of this violation.

Mel Parks recently attended a meeting of The San Antonio Mustang Club while he was in Texas. This club is not affiliated with the MCA but seems to be a strong and active group. Horace

Wood will contact the group to encourage them to become affiliated with us.

Bill Koivu pointed out that memberships actually run for 13 months rather than 12. Present procedures will be changed so that all memberships run for 12 months. The address label for the magazine will be changed back to original form to show membership expiration date rather than membership number.

All mail concerning "The Mustang Times" is to be addressed directly to The Mustang Club of America. The addresses shown in "The Mustang Times" will be changed to reflect this decision.

We are currently running low on envelopes and need to have more printed. John Henderson will check into the possibility of having the envelopes and membership cards printed at cost. He will advise the Board of the price at a later date.

A motion was made and approved to adjourn the meeting.
