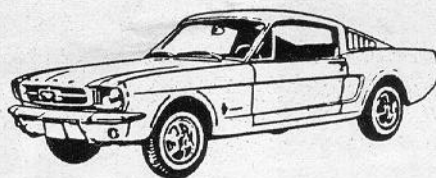

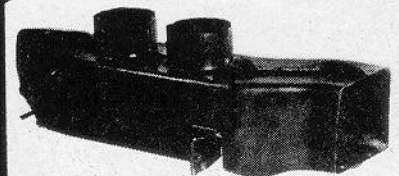

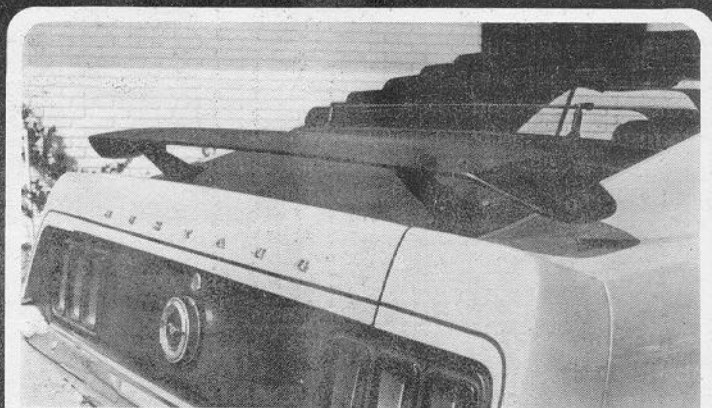
South Jersey Regional Mustang Club
