JERRY JECKLIN WINS CONVERTIBLE AT EASTERN NATIONAL

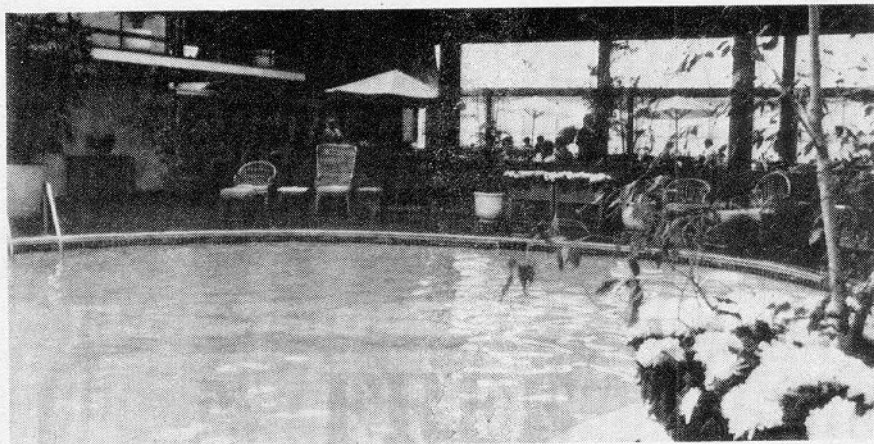
