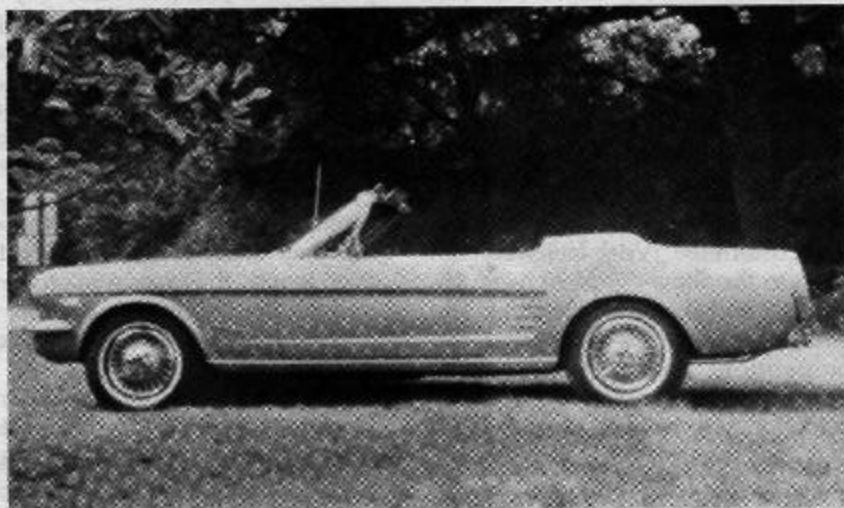


Gulf Coast Regional Tells Show Plans
