

From the National Head Judge

The response to our questionnaire in the November issue of *Mustang Times* was a success. We received many more responses than expected.

One hundred percent of the people responding had attended a MCA sponsored show. Ninety percent had entered a car to be judged, and 100% had at some time read the judging rules published in the February 1982 *Mustang Times*.

Question no. 4 drew a mixture of responses, but most members seemed to favor answer "a" (give multiple 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place awards to cars that score within 5 points of each other and consider them ties).

Question no. 5 was very close, but answer "b" (have the option of further competition or retiring the car) won by a slim margin.

The overwhelming response to question no. 6 was that things should *not* be left as they are.

Question no. 7 also drew a mixture of responses; however, it seems that most members still prefer trophies secured by the hosting regional group to plaques or standardized trophies.

My thanks to those who took the time to respond to this questionnaire. The responses received, in addition to the letters and suggestions, will be taken into consideration by the 1983 Judging Rules Committee.
