Donald and Cindy Chandler are the proud owners of this Ivy Green 1967 GTA fastback. Donald purchased the car from a customer of the grocery store that he managed back in November 1980. During the next year and a half, the car underwent a complete restoration and was first shown at the March 1982 Pensacola show. In May 1982 the car won its first National show in Atlanta and before the 1982 show season ended the '67 had become a Senior Division car. As happens to most members after the first taste of Mustang shows, the Chandlers try to attend most all the shows or at least the ones their schedule will permit.

The '67 is equipped with the 390 Thunderbird Special V-8, automatic transmission, all the usual GT options, style steel wheels, AM tape player, deluxe interior with an overhead console, and rear deck grills. This is a big block Mustang at its best.

Also in the Chandler's collection of cars is a 1968½ Cobra Jet 428 car and a 1967 GTA coupe Donald's father bought new and later sold. The coupe was later found and purchased back and will become the next restoration project. This car also has a 390 V-8 and some unusual options such as a tilt-away steering wheel along with air conditioning, deluxe interior and the list goes on.

Donald drives a 1966 GT fastback to and from work, but approximately two months ago it met with an unfortunate accident that left the entire front end wrecked. Undoubtedly the fastback will be back on the road shortly. Such is the life of a true Mustang enthusiast.
