



## Rangoon Red Convertible

John Waldron was a resident of Honolulu, Hawaii in 1965 and it was there that he purchased his 1965 convertible. This Rangoon red convertible was manufactured on January 13, 1965 at the San Jose plant and is equipped with standard interior, full length console, woodgrain steering wheel, day/night mirror, 289 engine with dress-up kit, automatic transmission, style steel wheels and white convertible top.

In 1967 John moved to Pennsylvania taking his convertible with him. During the years the car has been used not only by John but also by members of his family resulting in 107,000 miles. New floor pans and torque boxes have been installed and the engine has been completely detailed with the assistance of Mid-County Mustang in Exton, Pennsylvania.

The convertible is carefully maintained and is now used on a more limited basis. With each appearance this pony draws plenty of attention.
