SUBJECT: BY-LAW CHANGE "INPUT"

Why second chance? Because, only six (6) Regional Groups and thirty five (35) individuals took the time to write M.C.A. stating their opinion. It would seem that more than 7% of the Regional Groups and 1/2 of 1% of the members would have an opinion on this important issue.

The Board of Directors has postponed further discussion on this matter until the April 9, 1985 meeting.

So here is your "second chance"! Included with this letter to Regional Groups is a self-addressed post card for Regional Group feedback. The Board of Directors requests Regional Groups have an open discussion and vote on this By-Law change among its members. Please record the results on the post card and return to National Headquarters before March 31, 1985.

To be considered, the input card must be complete and signed by the Regional Group President and National Director.

As many members do not belong to Regional Groups, the February 1985 issue of Mustang Times will include an "opinion" sheet so all Mustang Club of America members can easily respond.

If we don't hear from you, the Board of Directors will have to assume that your Regional Group doesn't really care.
