The July 9, 1985 meeting was called to order by the president.

Roll Call was made with 20 members responding.

OLD BUSINESS

1. Craig Zion of Central South Carolina Regional Group has been in contact with Horace Wood and advised the trophy problem from last Fall's show is being handled.

2. David Hicks submitted his resignation from the Board due to a serious illness in his immediate family.

3. A motion was made and approved to purchase 12 dozen "10th Anniversary" T-Shirts to be added to the Club's merchandising items.

NEW BUSINESS

1. As a possible money-making project for the Club, Jim Osborn presented a line of trophies which would become a standard for all National Shows. After much discussion, it was decided that we didn't want to be in the trophy business.

2. Mel Parks presented comments to the Board from Bob Murphy stating his discontent with the "Retired" Class at National Shows. He felt that the retired division was not being handled properly, i.e., having to pay to register, etc. It was stated that this class is a voluntary one and that each host club draws its own conclusions as to fees, etc.

3. Horace Wood stated that the Three Rivers Mustang Club of Pittsburgh, PA returned their charter. At the same time, he presented a request for a new group Classic Mustangs of Southwestern Pennsylvania, Pittsburgh, PA encompassing the same territory. This group was approved as submitted.

An application was also presented from Sun Coast Mustang Club in Dunedin, FL. There is a conflict in territories with the Brooksville group. The

group was approved as submitted . . . the territorial map was held in abeyance until the territory can be worked out.

4. A request was received from First Pennsylvania Regional Group to host the 1986 Grand National in Valley Forge, PA over Labor Day Weekend, 1986. Horace Wood is to confer with this group as well as the group in Albuquerque, NM to see what can be worked out.

With there being no further business, the meeting was adjourned. Next meeting Tuesday, August 13, 7:30 p.m., Presidential Hotel.
